- Sanitation Report D. Kallio moved, L. Yelle seconded, to approve sending a letter to residents on Silver Creek Drive to inform them that if their road condition does not improve, they will need to bring their garbage down to Silver Creek Road for pickup. - a. Additional Road Repair Costs (overhead) D. Walch moved, J. Yelle seconded, to approve the additional cost of \$5,382.91 for the HMA resurfacing work and \$915.48 for Silver Creek Road, both of which were the overhead charges from the Road Commission for the projects. - **b.** Additional Charges for Dust Control D. Kallio moved, J. Murawski seconded, to approve an additional \$924.71 for dust control. Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Motion carried.
- c. Pavement Repair Hall 2 D. Kallio moved, J. Yelle seconded, to approve the \$750 for Superior Paving to do the pavement repair at Fire Hall #2, unless the fire department would like to investigate having the whole area resurfaced at the same time. Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Motion carried.
- **d.** New Planning Commission Appointment D. Walch moved, L. Yelle seconded, to appoint Cory Bushong to the Planning Commission. Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Motion carried.
- e. Water Testing Near Old Dump Dave Kallio and Jim Noe will check to see if any of the monitoring wells near the old dump are able to be tested.
- f. Design Plans for New Facility On hold; waiting for additional information.
- **g.** Letter of Support for Roundabout to MDOT and MCRC J. Yelle moved, L. Yelle seconded, to send a letter to both MDOT and the Marquette County Road Commission supporting a roundabout at the Crossroads.
