- At time of closure and/or abandonment (no longer used) recovery of the area will be reclaimed to its natural state including grading to no more than a 25% grade, top soil as needed for seeding of area and trees, per zoning ordinance section 414 (C) within one year.
- Shall maintain no less that a fifty (50) additional setback from any and all waterways.
- Reclamation shall be accomplished in stages, as areas are no longer used.
